Catholic Academy of Sussex County Summer Reading Assignment for Students Entering 6th Grade 2022 – 2023

1. Students entering **sixth grade** in September are required to read ONE fiction novel with a minimum of 200 pages that is on grade level and of interest. Please do not read books that are a part of a series or graphic novels.

2. Students are then required to complete a **Digital Book Report** using guide questions that support reading comprehension. See project details attached.

Overview of Project:

- Students will create a Google Slides presentation.
- Answer each guide question on the slide stated in the directions.
- You may need more than one slide for some questions.
- Slide may use bullet points, but answers should be in complete sentences.
- The presentation may be <u>submitted via email</u> to your teacher any time after the first day of school (Thursday, September 1st).
 - Teachers will provide students with their emails on the first day. They are also available on the school website. Further explanation and directions concerning submissions will be given the first week of school.

Directions:

Every slide should contain a typed explanation of each question below. You may include pictures having to do with the novel.

- Include the following categories in your presentation:
 - a. <u>Title Slide:</u>
 - i. Include name of novel, author, and your name on slide.
 - ii. Include pictures.
 - b. <u>Summary:</u> (1-2 slides)
 - i. Give a 1-2 paragraph summary of your novel.
 - c. <u>Central Idea:</u> (1-2 slides)
 - i. What is the central idea of the whole novel?
 - ii. Provide evidence from the novel to support your answer.
 - d. Character Development: (1-2 slides)
 - i. How does the main character change throughout the novel?
 - ii. Provide specific examples from the novel to support your answer.
 - e. <u>Author's Message:</u> (1 slide)
 - i. What do you think is the author's overall message in the novel?
 - ii. Provide specific examples from the novel to support your answer.
 - f. <u>Quote:</u> (1 slide)
 - i. Choose any significant quote that relates to the overall meaning of the novel.
 - ii. Explain the quote in your own words and explain how it relates to the overall message.
 - g. Real Life Connections: (1-2 slides)
 - i. What connections from the book can you make to your own life?
 - ii. Provide specific reasons for any connections you make.
